N On 4-17-91, at approximately 1445 hrs., contact was made with [redacted] at this location by Det Ronnfeldt and Det Thomas and was interviewed regarding any knowledge of the Bloomington Bus Center armed robbery and the Clark Oil Station homicide. [redacted] was positive that she had a conversation with [redacted] at the time her boyfriend) a little after 9:00PM on Easter Sunday at [redacted] in [redacted] bedroom. The conversation centered around [redacted] involvement in the Clark Oil Station homicide. [redacted] told [redacted] that [redacted] had just been to [redacted] residence and left prior to [redacted] arrival and [redacted] had told [redacted] that he had shot a guy. [redacted] said he was not with [redacted] and he thought [redacted] had gotten \$30.00 from the incident. [redacted] never saw a weapon nor heard anything else except that her sister, [redacted] dates [redacted] and she was told by [redacted] that the extra money he had on him at the time (next day) (unknown amount) was given to him by his grandmother.

On 2 MAR 91, [redacted] related another incident to [redacted] regarding the armed robbery that took place on that same date, a Saturday night. She remembered the date because an armed robbery had just taken place at the Bloomington Bus Center the night before. [redacted] told [redacted] that [redacted] and [redacted] from Detroit robbed the Bloomington Bus Center that night, 2 MAR 91. [redacted] stated that [redacted] would know [redacted] address in Detroit because he went to Detroit

about 1½ months ago either with [redacted] or to [redacted]
